

Options for Donations to St. Peter's Mountain Centers

First Decision: One time or Ongoing (Monthly/Quarterly)

Second Decision: Designated or Undesignated Gift(s)

Examples – One time Gift

#1: One Time, Undesignated:

- a. \$200 (or any amount) to be used as needed

#2: One Time, Designated:

- a. \$100 to be used for purchase textbooks
- b. \$250 to be used for school lunch expenses
- c. \$400 to be used to pay for yearly accounting service

Examples – Ongoing Gift

#1: Ongoing, Undesignated:

- a. \$25 monthly to be used as needed
- b. \$60 quarterly to be used as needed

#2: Ongoing, Designated

- a. \$15/month for tuition for one child
- b. \$25/quarter to buy supplies for Women's Center
- c. \$30/month to go towards teacher's salaries
- d. \$100/quarter to go towards rent

Needs	Costs	Notes
Tuition	\$15/month/child	If desired, Peter will assign your tuition to a specific child and will send a picture to you. The child will be encouraged to write a letter to you, and from then on you are free to correspond with that child as often as you would like
School lunch	\$11/month/child=current cost of rice/beans	Peter's food costs are steadily increasing. He estimates it may cost him more like \$1/day for 2019.
Lunch-Add the foods	\$200 to supplement the meals with vegetables, meat, and/or fruit	Currently the children receive only rice and beans, which for many is the only meal of their day. For a more complete diet, children should add vegetables, fruit and/or meat to weekly diet.
Teacher's salary	\$120/month=current salary.	Peter can only afford to pay \$120/mo. at this time. At this rate, he is always at risk of losing teachers to other schools that pay more. Furthermore, there are months that he can't even pay them the full \$120. The government recommended salary is \$240/month
Rent	\$250/month=current rent	Peter needs to relocate the school to a safer environment, which means rent will likely increase to \$250. Long term goal is to build a new school.
Textbooks-Need approx 80	Each book costs \$5.	Currently there is 1 textbook for 4 children. The children copy everything from the textbook for themselves. They have books for English, Science, Math, Social Studies, Christian education, and Kiswahili (their native language).
Desks	\$30/desk for 3 kids	Each desk is shared by 3 children. The current ones need repairs.
Accounting Service	\$50/month	Provides all financial reporting for month/year end
